Whether you choose to fly in or travel overland all locations offer easy access. Stansted has excellent car, bus and rail links, with a convenient station. There is a free bus service between bays 4-7 at the terminal to the Stansted Business Park, and free parking.

FULL MEDICAL SERVICE

Pilots can attend CAA medicals within 45 days of the expiry date of their current medical certificate. In these cases a new certificate can be issued from the date of expiry.

Carrying out hundreds of pilot medicals a year, Dr Orton has a wealth of experience. Currently a private, CPL and IR pilot, and previously a glider pilot, he has a clear and full understanding of the difficulties and challenges that pilots may face.

A comprehensive advisory service is available should pilots have any concerns or questions about forthcoming medical examinations.

FAST RESULTS

Medicals will last approximately one hour. The use of modern computerised equipment at each centre gives accurate, consistent and instantaneous results for the various required tests, enabling your initial medical and renewal certificates to be issued instantly in the majority of cases.

The following outlines the current CAA(JAR) medical requirements:

* A certificate issued prior to the holder's 40th birthday will not be valid for class 2 privileges after the 42nd birthday.

COST-INCLUSIVE PACKAGE

The medical package as shown in our current fees leaflet is cost-inclusive for the additional tests of haemoglobin and lung function. Fees also include the initial PPL eye test.

WHAT TO BRING TO A MEDICAL

- Pilots Licence
- Medical Certificate
- Log Book
- Optician's Report (for those requiring corrective vision)

For pilots requiring corrective vision please bring your glasses and current optician's report, performed within the last 6 months for initial class 2 medicals and within the last 2 years for class 1 medicals. If you normally use contact lenses you should also bring your glasses as you will need to remove your lenses during the medical.

HOW TO BOOK

A professional and knowledgeable booking service is available through reception at Aviation Medica at Stansted, Andrewsfield and Stapleford. Please ask for an appointment with Dr Orton.
